





- Do not use if damaged or defective. Do not disassemble shredder. Do not place near or over heat source or water.
- This shredder has a Disconnect Power Switch (I) that must be in the ON (1) position to operate shredder. In case of emergency, move switch to OFF (0) position. This action will stop shredder immediately.

- Avoid touching exposed cutting blades under shredder head.
- Keep finger away from CD hole when shredding.
- Do not put foreign objects in paper entry.
- The grounded socket-outlet shall be installed near the equipment and shall be

INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS




- 1. Place shredder against the wall (drywall, wooden, or concrete). Mark screw locations on wall through back of cabinet.
- 2. Drill 1/4" hole in wall for the anchor plugs.
- 3. Insert white plastic anchor plugs into drilled holes.
- 4. Insert (2) screws through back of cabinet and thread black rubber spacer onto the screw.
- 5. From inside cabinet use Phillips screw driver to secure shredder to the wall.

Press (🖰) ON to activate



Feed paper/card straight into paper entry and release



Hold CD at edge. To shred CDs rotate CD flap into place feed into CD entry and release



When finished shredding set to OFF (\circlearrowleft)



PREVENTIVE MAINTENANCE AND MISCELLANEOUS TROUBLESHOOTING

- For peak performance, we recommend oiling shredder each time waste bin is emptied. Only use a non-aerosol vegetable oil. Machines not oiled may lose sheet capacity, become noisy, and ultimately, stop running.
- Though paper detection sensors are designed to be maintenance free, the sensors occasionally become blocked by paper dust, causing the motor to run even if there is no paper present. Both sensors are located in the center of the paper entry.
- Self Cleaning Cycle: Shredder periodically cycles in forward and reverse lasting 3-6 seconds.
- Empty wastebasket when bin full indicator lights up.
- Shredder won't run if the door is open, or bin needs to be emptied.
- Maintenance is an important part of protecting your investment. Don't forget our oil (35250) and shredder bags (36054).
- When shredding for a prolonged period of time, the motor can become warm and require a cool down period. When this occurs the overheat indicator will alert you to the problem, this model will require 45 minutes to cool down.
