The [AeraMax](#)™ range can actively reduce the number of harmful airborne particles that could be severely affecting the health and wellbeing of families in homes across the UK.

Mould spores, dust mites, household chemical vapours, pollen, germs and viruses all contribute to poor indoor air quality, which studies show can be up to five times more polluted than outdoor air.¹

45% of people who took part in a survey for [Fellowes](#) said someone in their household suffers from airborne allergies.* Fellowes **AeraMax**™ Air Purifiers use a four-stage purification system that filters airborne pollution, helping to reduce the risks of allergy and illness in the family home.

Each of the three machines in the **AeraMax**™ range features a True HEPA filter. This is an EU certified level of 'High Efficiency Particulate Absorption', which removes 99.97% of airborne impurities as small as 0.3microns.

That's small enough to remove airborne particles including dust mites faeces (a common cause of allergies and poor health). Most people would be horrified to realise that just 437 grains of dust in their home contain nearly 42,000 living dust mites – with each mite expelling 20 fecal pellets every day.¹

Pets may be a loved family member but they do produce dander and dust which can cause harmful allergies and unpleasant odours. The **AeraMax**™ **Carbon Filter** removes these unpleasant odours as well capturing larger airborne particles. Additionally, the machines' **AeraSafe**™ **Antimicrobial Treatment** provides built-in protection from the potential growth of any odour causing bacteria, mildew and fungi on the True HEPA filter.

Air Purifiers come in three sizes. For parents of children who live every day with the misery of asthma or hay fever allergies the **AeraMax™ DX5** Air Purifier is recommended for rooms up to 8m² - perfect for a child's bedroom.

For a larger family room or living space up to 18m², the **AeraMax™ DX55** Air Purifier is ideal. The larger **AeraMax™ DX95** is recommended for shared living space up to 28m².

As well as its high performance features, the **AeraMax™** boasts a sensor which monitors air quality and automatically adjusts the fan speed to keep air purified. Blue, amber and red lights indicate the purity of the air. Its **Aera+™ Mode** is designed for peak allergy conditions and can increase airflow by up to 35% or 50% depending on the size of model.

The intelligent auto mode ensures that the unit only operates at a fan speed that reflects the quality of the air in the room, monitoring in real time and adjusting the fan speed accordingly. Sensors indicate when the Carbon and HEPA filters need to be replaced.
