

NOUN

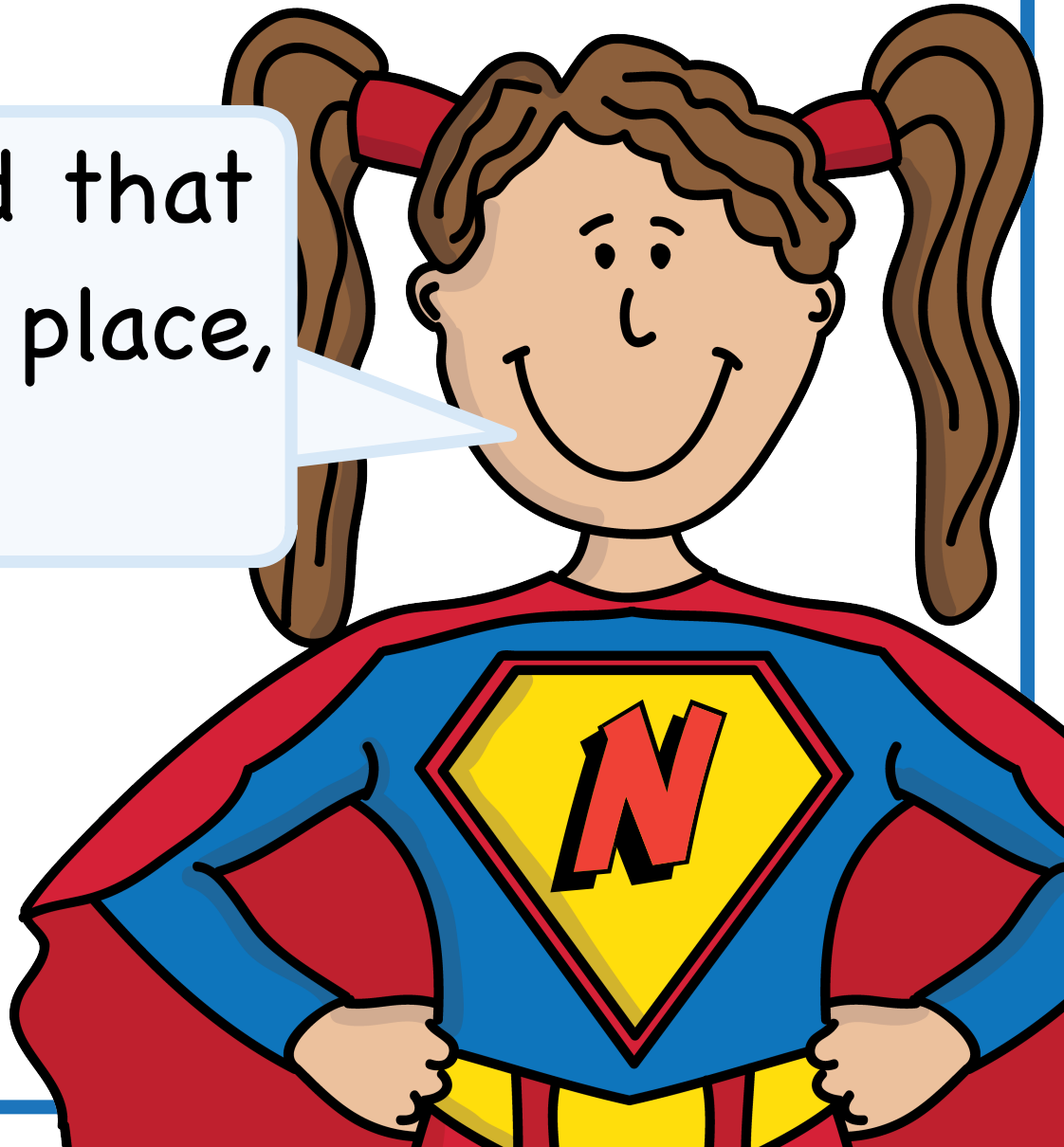
A **noun** is a word that names a person, place, thing or idea.

Idea : **joy**

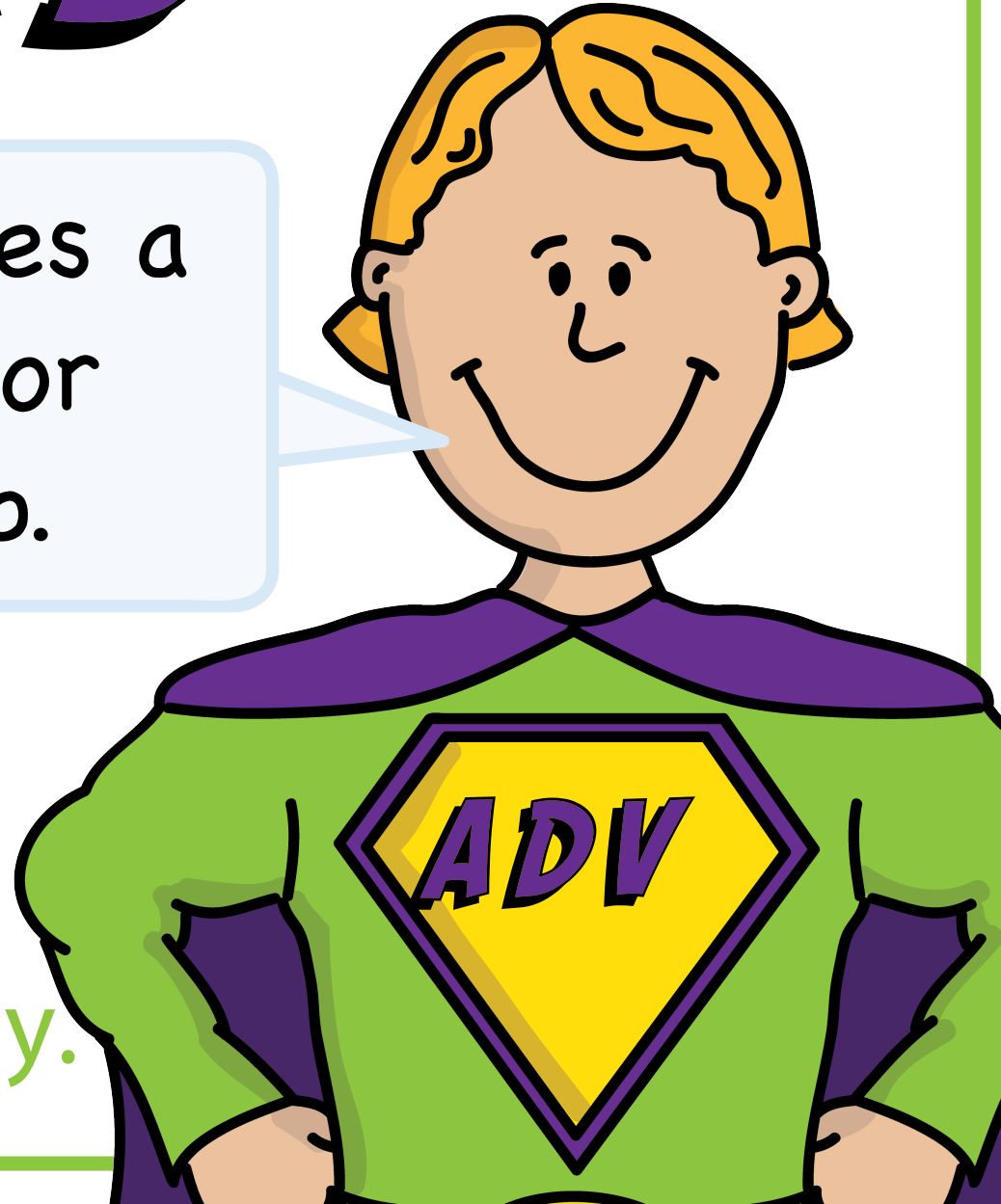


ADVERB

They talked **loudly**.

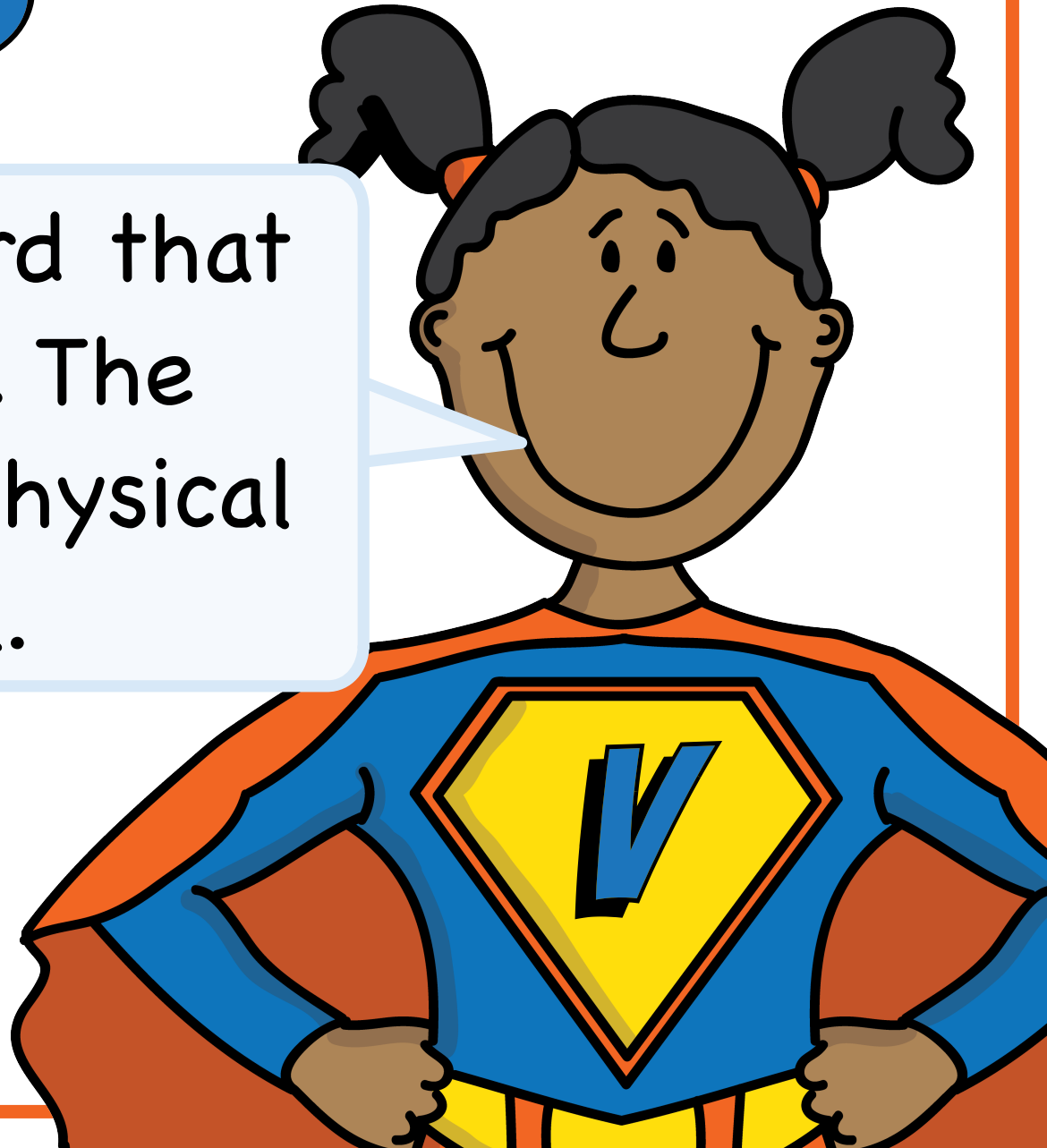
She danced **beautifully**.

A **verb** is a word that shows actions. The action can be physical or mental.

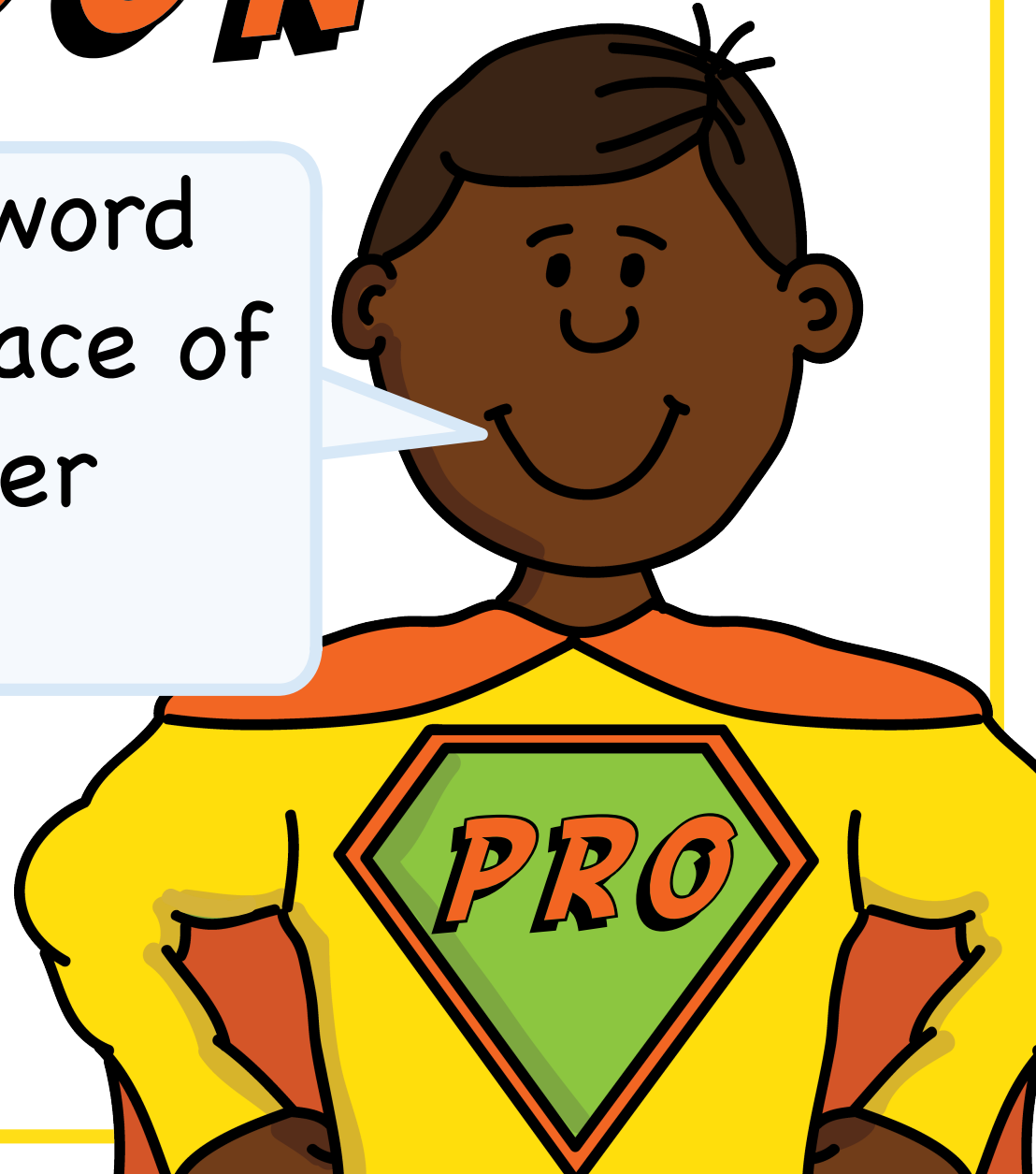
run popped

because for



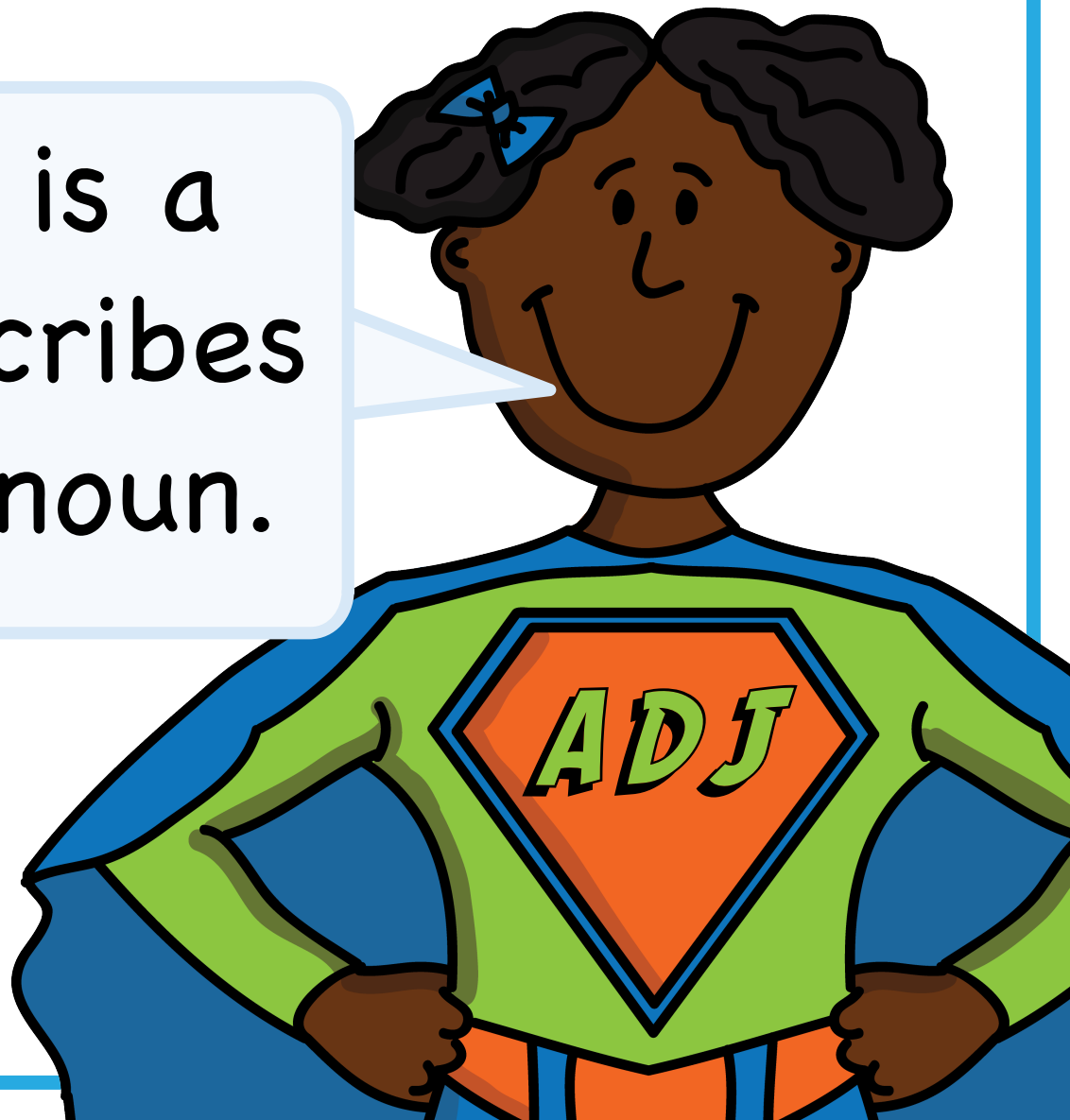
ADJECTIVE
